Barrier:

"an obstacle that prevents movement or access"

Mark 2:15-16 (ESV)

15 "And as he reclined at table in his house, many tax collectors and sinners were reclining with Jesus and his disciples, for there were many who followed him. **16** And the scribes of the Pharisees, when they saw that he was eating with sinners and tax collectors, said to his disciples, 'Why does he eat with tax collectors and sinners?'"

Jesus tore down <u>BARRIERS</u> between <u>GOD/MAN</u> and <u>MAN/MAN</u>.

Acts 2:5-8 (ESV)

5 Now there were dwelling in Jerusalem Jews, devout men from every nation under heaven. **6** And at this sound the multitude came together, and they were bewildered, because each one was hearing them speak in his own language. **7** And they were amazed and astonished, saying, 'Are not all these who are speaking Galileans? **8** And how is it that we hear, each of us in his own native language?""

Pentecost demonstrates God's invitation to <u>ALL PEOPLE</u> to enter His Kingdom.

The impact of Pentecost is that **BARRIERS** have been **BROKEN**.
