Matthew 6:9-13 (NKJV)

9 "In this manner, therefore, pray: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. **10** Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. **11** Give us this day our daily bread. **12** And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. **13** And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one. For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen."

A CONTINUING MESSAGE AFTER THE AMEN...

Matthew 6:14-15 (NKJV)

14 "For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. **15** But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

SOME TRUTHS ABOUT FORGIVENESS...

 Forgiveness assumes the <u>DEBT</u> and pays the penalty for <u>OFFENSE</u>.

2 Corinthians 5:21 (NIV)

21 "God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in Him we might become the righteousness of God."

 Unforgiveness is a tool that Satan uses to <u>DERAIL</u> the purposes of God in my life.

Ephesians 4:26-27 (NIV)

26 "In your anger do not sin: Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry, **27** and do not give the devil a foothold."

• Forgiveness releases the <u>OVERFLOW</u> of favor and blessing.

Romans	4:7	(AMP)
--------	-----	-------

7 "Blessed and happy and favored are those whose lawless acts have been forgiven, and whose sins have been covered up and completely buried."

Application Challenge:

HOW CAN I FORGIVE?

1. Confess the inner **STRUGGLE** you are having.

1 John 1:9 (NKJV)

- **9** "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."
- 2. Ask God for a change of **HEART**.
- 3. Speak forgiveness out **LOUD**.

Romans 10:9-10 (NIV)

9 "If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. **10** For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved."

4. Forgive again **TOMORROW!**
