Luke 23:32-34 (ESV)

32 Two others, who were criminals, were led away to be put to death with him. **33** And when they came to the place that is called The Skull, there they crucified him, and the criminals, one on his right and one on his left. **34** And Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do."

Jesus does not **LIMIT** His **FORGIVENESS**.

Luke 23:42-43 (ESV)

42 And he said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom." **43** And He said to him, "Truly, I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise."

Jesus is the **ETERNAL DOOR**.

John 10:9-10 (ESV)

9 I am the door. If anyone enters by me, he will be saved and will go in and out and find pasture. **10** The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life and have it abundantly.

Luke 23:44-46 (ESV)

44 It was now about the sixth hour, and there was darkness over the whole land until the ninth hour, **45** while the sun's light failed. And the curtain of the temple was torn in two. **46** Then Jesus, calling out with a loud voice, said, "Father, into your hands I commit my spirit!" And having said this he breathed his last.

Jesus **TRUSTED** His **FATHER**.

Application Challenge:

How do Jesus' final moments encourage or challenge you?

Consider the fact that Jesus offered forgiveness to those who mocked Him, to His friends who disowned Him, and even to those who crucified Him. Jesus died to forgive all sin, even your worst sin! What would it look like for you to believe and trust that Jesus offers **complete forgiveness** for everyone who has faith to ask Him for it?
