We always think if we get together the right formula, magic will happen.

How often do I search for the things of God instead of God Himself?

<u>Questions</u> make room for faith.

Our wrestling is a catalyst for a relationship.

Prayer is an ongoing <u>conversation</u> with God. How God communicates to each of us is going to be different for each of us.

Establishing a rhythm with <u>God</u> gives us a rhythm to <u>life</u>.

(verses written out on screen) Matthew 14:22-33 NIV Mark 6:51-52 NIV

The way to God is through our heart.

To know His <u>voice</u>, we need to know <u>Him</u>.

Longevity of our relationship with God expands our <u>view</u> of God.

God not only wants you to know Him, He wants you to know you.

God is not as interested in the purity of our heart as He is our awareness of the reality of our heart.

Our continual conversation with God leads to an <u>encounter</u> with God.

Giving God space to connect also gives Him space to work.

God works through the simple things to reveal big things.

Our relationship with God should be one of exploration.
