Luke 3:21-22 (ESV)

21 "Now when all the people were baptized, and when <u>Jesus also</u> <u>had been baptized</u> and was praying, the heavens were opened,
22 and the Holy Spirit descended on Him in bodily form, like a dove; and a voice came from heaven, "You are my beloved Son; with You I am well pleased."

Matthew 28:18-20 (ESV)

18 "And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, **baptizing them** in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."
